The meeting of the District Level Task Force Committee, Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) was presided over by Sri A. Rajkhowa, ACS, the District Development Commissioner, Nagaon and welcomed the members present in the meeting. The Chairman asked the Member Secretary of the Committee and the General Manager, District Industries & Commerce Centre, Nagaon to elaborate objectives of the meeting.

The General Manager, DI&CC, Nagaon informed the house about target received for PMEGP as below-

During interview it is observed that more nos. of youths were found eligible for selection. The Member Secretary placed the letter received from Director, KVIC, Rupnagar, Guwahati-32 vide letter No. ASM/ PMEGP/ Target (14-15)/ 2015-16/ 783, Dtd.12-06-2015 where they mentioned not to select over the margin money allotted. Again another letter received from the Commissioner of Industries & Commerce, Assam, Udyog Bhawan, Bamunimaidam, Guwahati-21 vide letter No. CI&C(US)PMEGP/ Misc./ 154/ 2009/ 294/ 22878-904, Dtd. 31st July, 2015. In this letter it is mentioned to keep not more than 5% of the target as reserved merit wise, to replace any of the selected candidates if rejected by bank. Also the member secretary informed the house compiling total interview sheets, the list prepared provisionally as mentioned below. As huge numbers of eligible applicant to be accommodated within the perview of the target the scheme amount has been reduced to bare need.

After threadbare discussion regarding selection of PMEGP beneficiaries 5% above the margin money allotted to Nagaon, the committee decided to finalized the list as mentioned above and request the General Manager, DI&CC, Nagaon to sponsor all proposals of selected beneficiaries to the concern bank branches as last year experience reveals that bank hasn't sanctioned all the proposals sponsored to the bank.



He also stressed that the bank should check the proposals and return if found not suitable for sanction describing the details reason thereof. The Lead District Manager assured to take suitable step regarding the matter.

Further, committee decided to select and keep reserve another 5% proposals to sponsor to the bank if any proposal return by bank due to genuine ground with a view to achieve the 100% of target.

The Committee has decided to select 10% excess than the allotted target of Margin Money with a view to achieve the 100% target.
